It is that time again! A chance to get together with your friends for a transport related day out.

Details of the 2015 LUPTS Bus Tour are here.

Further activities may be arranged for the Friday and Sunday. Details will be advised in due course and the website www.lupts.org.uk will be updated accordingly.

This year the LUPTS Bus tour visits three railways. The transport to get there will be provided by ex-Royal Blue Bristol RELH 837 SUO (subject to availability).



First, we visit the **Llangollen Railway** to ride the full length of the line including their new extension to Corwen (East). We hope to have reserved seats at the front of the train so as to have a good view.

Then we head on to the **Talylyn Railway** where we arrive at Abergynolwyn station. There should be the opportunity to inspect the Blockpost before heading down to Tywyn on the 12:10 train. There will also be the opportunity for a guided tour of the Works at Pendre for those that so wish. At Tywyn Wharf the Talylyn Railway will be



marking the 150th anniversary of the first running of trains on the Talylyn with special events and activities. There will be time to visit The Narrow Gauge Railway Museum and enjoy lunch and a pint in Kings Cafe.

Finally we visit the **Corris Railway** where we are greeted with complimentary drinks and bara brith before viewing their displays



and riding on the line to Maespoeth for a guided tour of the Engine and Carriage Sheds.

After Corris we head straight back to Liverpool aiming for an arrival at around 20:00. Please note that on the journey to Liverpool there will be a brief convenience

stop but there will not be a meal or pub stop as there will be more choice and time available for this on arrival back in Liverpool.

Remarkably, this package can be yours for only **£35.00** for Adults/Seniors and **£25.00** for Children. The Llangollen Railway require advance confirmation of numbers for group bookings, so please make your booking as soon as possible.

Reduced fares will be fares available for passengers who wish to make their own arrangements for tickets at Llangollen and Talylyn. Reduce the fare by £5.00 if you wish to obtain your own ticket at Llangollen and by £4.00 at Talylyn. Please indicate on the booking form what discount you are claiming.

It is expected that there will be a lot of interest in the bus tour this year and in view of the seating capacity of the coach, **please book as soon as possible to guarantee your place.**
